**Objective** Brock has a love <u>of the DP</u>.

**Partitive** Most of Brock's stuff (of the stuff) of Brock) is right here.

Description The dude is a man **of great serenity**.

DATIVE:

Indirect Object They gave (to) <u>Brock</u> a round of snaps.

Reference Brock will go the extra distance <u>for a friend</u>.

Purpose With Brock, the usual rules of society act as (for) **a hindrance**.

Double (Purp+Ref) Probably, Brock was (for) **a worry** to **his parents**.

w/ Adjectives Brock is friendly to everyone.

**Possession** (w/ sum) Back off, man! That DP is **for the Brockster**.

Agent (w/ fut.pass.part.) The job was to be done **by Brock** by Thursday.

ACCUSATIVE:

**Direct Object** I love <u>that dude</u>.

Double (w/ rogo, doceo) Brock taught <u>me yoga</u>.

Time Duration Brock worked at the Stewart House <u>for two years</u>.

Place Toward This weekend Brock is going to <u>another blues festival</u>.

ABLATIVE - preposition?:

**Separation** -N It is not advised to keep Brock <u>from his DP</u>.

Cause – N I visit regularly **from a deep, abiding love** of the Brockman.

**Place From** – Y I am driving <u>away from Brock's restaurant</u> right now. ab, de, ex **Agent** (w/ passive) – Y That DP was sure sucked down quick **by the Brockmeister**. ab

Means – N Brock hit me with his rhythm stick.

Price – N Brock sold his beater for mucho dinero.

Degree of Difference – N Brock is way cooler (cooler <u>by much</u>) than most old guys.

**Specification** – N I yield to Brock in <u>laidbackness</u>.

Description – N The dude is an hombre <u>of mighty importance</u>.

Accompaniment - YI dig going anywhere with Brock.cumManner - YBrock lives life with a vengeance.cum

Time When – N Brock should get here <u>at 7 am</u> (AM?! What, are you kidding? <u>PM!</u>)

Place Where -Y Brock is in the house.

Absolute – N All things having been said, I repeat: Brock is a major, major dude.
